Emilia-Romagna region is looking for "Ideamocracy"

ideamocracy.it is a competition for ideas to for e-democracy initiatives, launched by the Emilia-Romagna regional government.

The Emilia-Romagna region has long been active in e-democracy initiatives, but they now want to innovate and identify new, disruptive opportunities. In particular, they want to use technology to widen the range of participants in e-democracy initiatives, through three technological opportunities: online games, social network and mobile apps, if properly combined and well designed, can transform the cost of participation into a direct benefit.

We're looking for new ideas that leverage social networks, online games and mobile apps. Examples are provided in the inspiration section (link). We're particularly interested in ideas applicable in the transport and energy regional policy, and that do not have an implementation costs for technology that surpasses 20.000 Euros.

By idea we mean a concept, described in 500 words, accompanied by visual tools such as presentation or video. The more detailed it is, the more chances to be well evaluated. We are not interested in ideas purely addressing the service delivery (such as transport timetable consultation), or in ideas already implemented in Italy.

Prizes are decided by the experts' jury. The criteria for selection are originality and innovation; feasibility and maturity of the idea; potential impact. All have equal importance. Any citizen of the EU can participate, alone or as a group.

The first prize is 3000 Euros, then 4 second prizes consist in an iPad 2.
